Speakers shall at all times conduct themselves in accordance with proper decorum. Profane or vulgar language or gestures will not be tolerated. Audience members shall not disrupt an open meeting by speaking without being recognized by the moderator and shall not incite others to do so. The moderator retains the right to remove disruptive attendees and individuals who fail to conduct themselves in accordance with these provisions from the meeting.
